Overview

During the second year of development, the POSEIDON Partners have provided dissemination information and materials to raise awareness across user groups about the possibilities of POSEIDON helping to integrate people with Down's syndrome in our society.

Dissemination activity has been via traditional and digital outlets: social media, printed journals, training events, industry seminars, POSEIDON workshops, questionnaires, one-to-one assessments etc.

During year 2, products were developed in relation to a home navigation system, a navigation app, a calendar app and an interactive cap tap table for money handling.

The products developed were tested during Pilot 1 by people with Down's syndrome and their parent/carer. An extended pilot is also planned for the first month of year 3.

Monthly activity from each partner is noted in the tables in this document.

Project meetings

During the second year of the project, POSEIDON project partners met in London, Luxembourg, Berlin and Darmstadt.

London - 25th - 27th November 2014, was an ordinary project meeting hosted by Middlesex University in Hendon. Topics were summary of the first year, planning for the second year and especially the pilot, which was run during summer - autumn 2015. In addition, we planned for the first period review.

Luxembourg – 26th - 27th January 2015, was the review hosted by the European Commission. On 26th January, the consortium prepared for the review. The review was on 27th January.

Berlin – 4th – 5th March 2015, was a planning meeting for pilot 1, hosted by Berliner Institute for Social Research.

Darmstadt – 6th – 7th October 2015, was a summary meeting for pilot 1 and planning meeting for pilot 2 to be run in April 2016. The meeting was hosted by Fraunhofer IGD.
